

Environmental Policy

The ultimate responsibility for the Environmental Management System is with the Board of Directors and the Chief Executive who provides the necessary financial and physical resources and ensures the Policy is reviewed annually. The Environmental Policy has the active commitment of our Board of Directors, who ensures it is communicated to all levels of the Company, monitor the effectiveness of our Environmental Management System and drive initiatives for continuous environmental improvement.
